

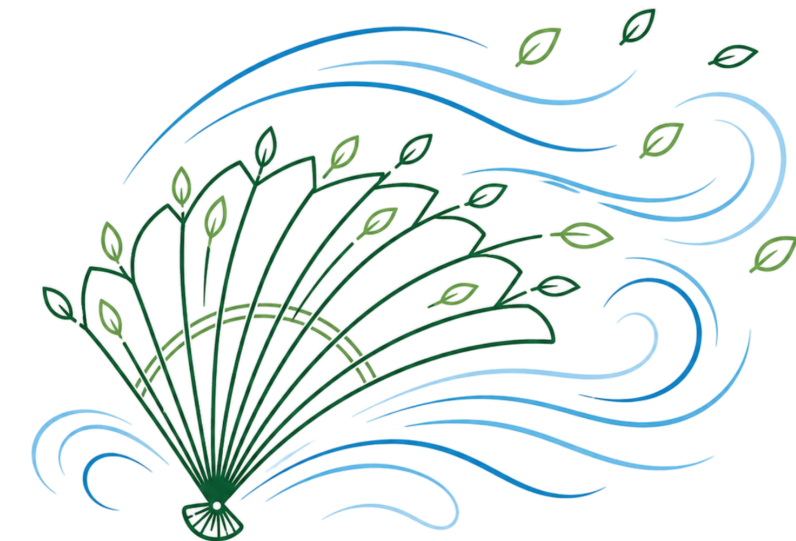

רוּחַ | ruach | 'roo-akh | noun — Hebrew

The word the Hebrew Bible uses for breath, wind, and Spirit, not as separate meanings but as one continuous reality experienced at different scales. The breath in your lungs, the wind in the trees, the Spirit of the God: same word.
